<b>Diagnostic and Preventive Services</b> – Used to diagnose and/or prevent dental abnormalities or disease (includes exams, cleanings, and fluoride treatments).	80%	80%	80%
<b>Emergency Palliative Treatment</b> – Used to temporarily relieve pain.	80%	80%	80%

<b>Radiographs</b> – X-Rays	80%	80%	80%
<b>Minor Restorative Services</b> – Used to repair teeth damaged by disease or injury (for example, fillings).	60%	60%	60%

<b>Simple Extractions</b> – Non surgical extraction of one or more teeth.	40%	40%	40%
