



# Can I get Extra Help with premium costs for 2025?

If you qualify for Extra Help, Medicare may pay some or all of your Part D premium. Extra Help is only for Part D prescription costs, not for medical benefits.

You must continue to pay Part B premiums.

The reduced amounts in the below charts reflect the Part D premium you will pay, and does not include the Part B premiums.
